## Join the Rapid Response EFCA Week of Action Help Pass S. 1041

Today, workers trying to organize are often subjected to illegal activities by the boss to stop them from forming a union. They are routinely intimidated, threatened and fired. Does Senator Voinovich care? Does he think it's ok for companies to throw workers out on the street just for trying to form a union? Why hasn't he made it clear that he will fight for us? **Why won't our Senator stand up for Ohio workers?**

So far, Senator Voinovich has refused to sponsor the Employee Free Choice Act (EFCA), S. 1041. The EFCA will give workers the ability to form a union in the workplace freely. Rapid Response is taking the lead in a major push from all AFL-CIO unions to pass S. 1041 in the Senate. This is the week we will focus on key senators who have not yet agreed to sponsor the bill. The EFCA has already passed in the U.S. House of Representatives, and now **we need Senator Voinovich to help us pass it in the U.S. Senate.**
